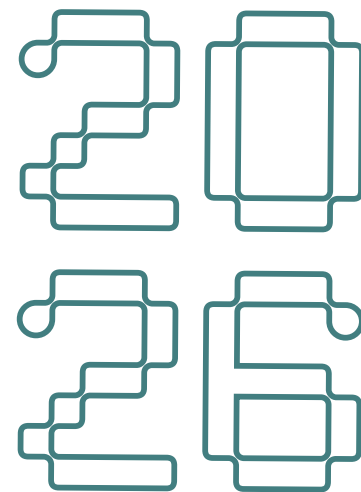

You may apply if you meet the following criterias

Med Track

Eligible

- Therapeutics – small molecules, biologics, and other biotech-based approaches
- Biotech-based diagnostic systems
- Biotech-based drug delivery systems
- AI or software platforms for drug or biomolecule discovery and design

Not Eligible

- Medical devices
- Digital health solutions
- AI, software or digital platforms not focused on drug discovery or design
- Wearables and wearable sensors, unless powered by a core biotech technology

Eco Track

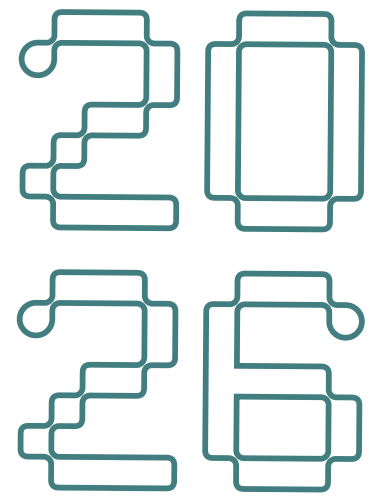
Eligible

- Any solutions based on living organisms, cells, microorganisms, or biological systems, with applications in any sector (i.e. Animal Health, Environment, Industry, Agri-food, etc.)

Not Eligible

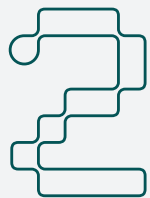
- Sustainability, circular economy or climate-tech projects without a biotech component
- Software, AI or digital-only solutions without a substantial biotech component
- Purely mechanical, electronic or chemical technologies that do not use living organisms or biological systems

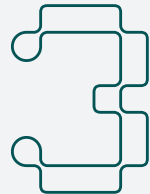
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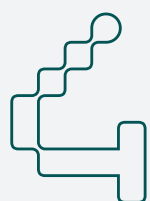
Applicant Profile

You are an early-career researcher aged 35 or under, able to serve as the project representative throughout the selection process and deliver the final pitch if selected. PhD students are eligible to apply.



IP Requirements

A patent application covering the main features of your invention must have been filed before applying. Projects based on patents that are 7 years old or older are not eligible.



Structure & Funding Stage

Academic projects, start up & spin-off are all eligible as long as have raised less than €2.5 million dilutive funding (research grants & non-dilutive grants do not count).
